Three PINORD wines voted: Year's Best by Wine&Spirits

Wine&Spirits Magazine, the prestigious, specialist magazine has included three Bodegues Pinord wines made at their Mas Blanc winery in DOCa. Priorat amongst the wines they recommend as this *YEAR'S BEST*.

Pinord makes their DOCa. Priorat wines using grapes grown at their 18 hectare Mas Blanc estate, which is located between the villages of Bellmunt del Priorat and Falset. They have implemented organic farming methods and have been recognised as pioneers in the application of biodynamic practices.

In 2007 Mas Blanc became the first Spanish winery to achieve the Demeter certificate (international non-profit organisation which oversees the implementation of biodynamic techniques).

Clos del Mas



Garnatxa (Grenache), Cabernet Sauvignon and Carinyena (Carignan)

Predominant fruit flavours are beautifully complemented by this wine's full body. It is packed with soft tannins, giving it a pleasant overall mouth feel.

Clos del Músic

Garnatxa (Grenache), Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah and Carinyena (Carignan)

Full of character, this wine's intense full body fills our mouth as we taste. Hints of fruit are mixed with tertiary aromas from the ageing in oak. It has a long and elegant finish.





Garnatxa (Grenache), Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah

This is a full and complex wine, which is soft and at the same time balanced in terms of palate. Red fruit aromas dominate in this wine, coupled with mineral tones from the local "Llicorella" terroir. It has a long-lasting finish.
